

Conditions of participation

By registering for this event, participants accept the following conditions and all disclaimers.

1. subject of the exhibition

The "Vintage Camper Days" is a classic car camping event. Vintage caravans, caravans, campervans or motorhomes older than 30 years may participate. The organizer will decide on the admission of younger vehicles on a case-by-case basis. Towing vehicles that do not meet the above criteria cannot be parked on the historic campsite. The museum's visitor parking lot is available for these vehicles.

2. date and duration of the event

The event will take place from August 7 to 9, 2026. Arrival is possible on Friday, August 7, from 12 noon. The event ends on Sunday, August 9, at 6 pm. Departure must take place by 8 p.m. at the latest.

3. conditions

The participation fee is 149€ for one person and 50€ for each additional person. The participation fee includes the pitch, electricity, sanitary facilities (shower, WC, washing-up facilities), museum admission for the entire weekend, all program items, bread service for Saturday and Sunday morning, food and drinks at saturday evening and an annual admission ticket for the Erwin Hymer Museum. Registration is binding; a refund of the registration fee is not possible in the event of non-participation.

4. registration/payment

Registration and payment shall be made via the webshop on the ERWIN HYMER MUSEUM website and shall not be completed until the participation fee has been paid in full. If no participation fee is transferred, the registration is invalid and the space will be allocated elsewhere by the organizer.

5. set-up/pitches

The set-up of the event will take place on Friday, August 7, between 12 and 8 pm. Vehicles may only be parked in the parking spaces designated for participants and in accordance with the prior instructions of the museum staff. Parking spaces will be allocated by the organizer. There is no entitlement to a specific parking space or parking space neighbor. Only the following vehicles or vehicle combinations are permitted on the individual parking spaces: Teams consisting of car and caravan, car and tent, motorhomes, camper vans. One awning is permitted per caravan, camper van and motorhome. Additional vehicles must be parked in the museum's visitor parking lot.

6. Electricity

There are several power distributors (230V) on the event site that can be used. You must bring your own connection and extension cables. Please note that the maximum usable power is limited to normal camping requirements.

7. safety regulations

Access routes, in particular fire department access routes, rescue routes, emergency exits and escape routes must be kept clear. Walking speed applies on the entire site. Persons who are not in possession of a valid driving license are prohibited from driving on the premises. Vehicle owners must ensure that these conditions are observed.



Drivers and vehicle owners are responsible for their own road safety. Participants are responsible for taking out any necessary insurance cover themselves.

8 Instructions of the organizer

The instructions of the organizer must be followed. Our staff is entitled to expel participants who do not comply with the instructions and to ban them from the premises. A refund of the participation fee is excluded.

9. responsibility of the organizer

The organizer has taken out liability insurance for the implementation of the event.

10. exclusion of liability

Each participant (driver, co-driver, vehicle owner, vehicle keeper) takes part in the event at his/her own risk and bears sole responsibility under criminal law for all damage caused by him/her or his/her vehicle.

By submitting their registration, participants declare that they waive all claims of any kind for damages arising in connection with the event against the organizer, its representatives and helpers as well as other participants in the event.

The organizer is exempt from any liability. The organizer does not agree to guard the participating vehicles.

11. Media coverage

Each participant agrees irrevocably and for all present and future media to the free use of his/her image and voice for photographers, live broadcasts, broadcasts and/or recordings of images and sound made by the organizer or its agents in connection with the event.

12. Changes

The organizer reserves the right to change the dates, conditions and prices at any time.

13. final provision

The invalidity of one or more of these provisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions. An ineffective provision shall not be omitted without replacement, but shall be replaced by a provision that comes as close as possible to the intended result and is effective.
